- Troubleshoot issues, as applicable, with cheese production.
- Maintain all required logs, records, inventories, recipes and data collected.
- Assist Sanitation Lead and Packaging Lead, when needed.
- Assist Creamery Management as needed in development and maintenance of all SOPs, SSOPs, GMPs.
- Perform routine, basic, and periodic evaluation of equipment fixtures and elements used throughout the creamery and caves to ensure optimal function.
- Assist with preparation and presentation of tours and farmer's market, as needed.

- Perform testing using various equipment, such as- a PH meter, a moisture analyzer, SCC, and a Residue ATP machine.
- Perform weekly environmental monitoring.
- Prepare product samples for product testing.
